n, our ability to stand fast against the attacks of international immunism will depend on our success in strengthening the economic desocial fabric of the free world. I hope that the North Atlantic reaty will become a powerful instrument for this purpose. I in glad that its members will have the opportunity to consider the rowing responsibilities and commitments of the alliance when the option of th

Finally, we in the West must be confident in the strength advalidity of our system of government, in the value of our own sciety and in our ability so to develop and adjust our way of life lat we can meet the challenge of our times. We must be confident so in the long-term strength of our position, firmer now than it is in 1945 and growing firmer year by year as the dividends begin come to hand from such great constructive policies as the arshall Plan and the North Atlantic Treaty.
