To Our Beloved and Faithful the Senators of the Dominion of Canada, and the Members elected to serve in the House of Commons of Our said Dominion, and to each and every of you,—GREETINGS:

A PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS Our Parliament of Canada was summoned to meet on the twenty-eighth day of the month of February, 1931, at which time at Our City of Ottawa, you were held and constrained to appear. Nevertheless, for certain causes and considerations, We do Will, by and with the advice of Our Privy Council for Canada, that you and each of you, be as to Us in this matter entirely exonerated, Commanding, and by the tenor of these Presents enjoining you, and each of you, and all others in this behalf interested, that on THURSDAY, the TWELFTH day of the month of MARCH next, 1931, at Our City of Ottawa, aforesaid, personally you be and appear, for the DESPATCH OF BUSINESS, to treat, do, act and conclude upon these things which in Our said Parliament of Canada, by the Common Council of Our said Dominion, may by the favour of God be ordained.

IN TESTIMONY WHEREOF, We have caused these Our Letters to be made Patent, and the Great Seal of Canada to be hereunto affixed. WITNESS: Our Right Trusty and Well-beloved Counsellor the Right Honourable Lyman Poore Duff, a member of Our Most Honourable Privy Council, Senior Judge of Our Supreme Court of Canada and Administrator of Our Government of Our Dominion of Canada.

At Our Government House, in Our City of OTTAWA, in Our said Dominion, this ninth day of February, in the year of Our Lord one thousand nine hundred and thirty-one and in the twenty-first year of Our Reign.
