Debate resumed; amendment proposed in amendment to the amendment by Mr. Desjardins (L'Islet); withdrawn, 389. Debate again adjourned, 390, 395, 406, 409, 410, 414, 418, 427, 430, 433, 435. Amendment negatived, 445. Main motion agreed to, 447. Resolutions further considered, 462-465. Resolution 1 (Items 2 and 4 amended), read a second time and agreed to, 465, 467. Resolution 2, agreed to; resolution 3, amended and agreed to; resolution 4, disagreed to; resolution 5 (Item 7 disagreed to); remaining items agreed to; resolution 6, read second time; Bill presented, 467. (See *Customs*). Resolution 5, referred to Committee of Whole on Inland Revenue Bill, 467. (See *Inland Revenue*, 2.) Bill founded on resolution 5. (See *Customs*.) Again in Committee; 3 resolutions amending certain sections of Bills of this Session adopted, 568. Reported and agreed to, 608.

Passed by Senate, 390. Royal Assent, 395. 54-55 Victoria, Chapter 1.
