1876 By the Honorable Mr. *Read* :—

February 16—That an humble Address be presented to His Excellency the Governor General, praying that His Excellency will cause to be laid before this House, copies of all correspondence between the Contractors of the Georgian Bay Branch Railway and the Government since the date of the contract.

By the Honorable Mr. *Kaulbach* :—

“ 16—That an humble Address be presented to His Excellency the Governor General, praying that His Excellency will cause to be laid before this House, a statement shewing the work performed by the Government Steam Dredge “Canadian,” during the past year with total cost of said work, the harbours dredged, with the quantity and cost of the work in each harbor, the number and classification of the crew and the wages paid to each of them. Also, the quantity of coal consumed by said dredge on each work, when and by whom supplied and the cost per ton or chaldron. Also, if any extra hands have been employed on any of the work or in the service as pilots or otherwise, if so, where; the service performed and the wages paid.
