1st Resolution—Moved by His Excellency the GOVERNOR GENERAL, seconded by R. Hamilton, Esq., V.P.

2nd Resolution—Moved by the Rev. M. M. Fothergill, and seconded by Denis Godley, Esq.

That this meeting desires to express its gratitude to ALMIGHTY GOD for the rapid growth and progress of the Anglican Church throughout the world in our day.—Carried.

3rd Resolution—Moved by T. Kirkpatrick, Esq., Q.C., seconded by George Irvine, Esq., supported by the Rev. J. L. Gay.

That this meeting desires to record the expression of its continued interest in the welfare of the Sister Societies in the other British North American Dioceses.—Carried.

4th Resolution—Moved by His Excellency the GOVERNOR GENERAL, and carried by acclamation.
