Lives and private Properties; but yet, in the Constitution of the French Offices, particularly as the same relate to America, there is a Spirit of Liberty runs through the whole of them, and they are fo excellently well contrived and calculated for the Improvement of their Trade, and Enlargement of their distant Colonies and Posfessions, that an Improvement (altho' from a foreign Stock) may be very properly engrafted into our System; nor is there any great Difficulty in fo doing, as the Regulations they have made are no more the natural Refult of their Constitution, than of ours; and altho' fome small Alterations may
