*How to Strike an Alarm.*—In opening a box, turn the key to the right hand; pull the door wide open, then shut it. The key, on shutting the door, will lock itself in, and will be relieved by the Chief Engineer, after an alarm of fire, and he shall deliver the key to the holder. Always pull the box nearest the fire.

*Mode of Striking High Numbers.*—For example: if the number 23 is struck, there are not twenty-three strokes given. There are first two strokes, with an interval of two seconds between each; then an interval of ten seconds,
