

The lecturer spoke particularly of the studies of the ancient civilization of the Mediterranean now being directed from the institute's school of archaeology in Santa Fe, New Mexico, but at the same time cast special emphasis on the worldwide character of the work of the organization with its branch societies in all the principal cities of the United States and Canada and in London, Paris, Rome, Athens, in Greece, Italy, Palestine and America, pointing out that the study of humanity which is the great function of the League is the real brotherhood of man.
