XI. Should an inmate become dissatisfied or unhappy, he or she is at liberty to leave the home, taking with them only such articles

as they brought to the Home.

XII. If any inmate shall not conform to the rules of the Home or behave rudely or improperly, such inmate may be discharged by the Weekly Committee at their first meeting after the insubordination has been duly investigated.
