prayer for the overthrow of intemperance and those kindred evils that have wrought the ruin of so many in all communities.

## SACRAMENTAL WINE.

We recommend that this General Conference recommend that as far as practicable non-alcoholic wine be used in the sacrament of the Lord's Supper in all our churches.

## MISCELLANEOUS.

We recommend the organization of Juvenile Temperance Societies in all our congregations; the use of total abstinence pledges in the home and school, and that a day be set apart in each year, to be known as Temperance Sunday, when the whole day shall be devoted to the temperance question.

Recognizing the great importance of the use of temperance text-books in all the schools of the Dominion, we recommend that steps be taken to secure the accomplishment of so desirable an object.

All of which is respectfully submitted.
