FIND SEVEN STILLS IN A SINGLE HOME

Largest Seizure Known in Toronto - Strong Odor of Whiskey Caused Neighbors to Make Complaint.

Many thirsty Toronto citizens who befell probably one of the city's largest illicit liquor enterprises last night at a house on Kingston road, where five stills in operation and two others which were undergoing repairs were seized and confiscated. As a result of the raid, two confiscated. As a result of the raid, two men are in custody, charged with operating an illicit liquor still and violating the Inland Revenue Act. They are Albert Arlis and John Cohen, both living at the Kingston road address. Arlis is named as owner of the distilling apparatus and Cohen as his helper and fellow-operator. The stills seized have each a capacity of twenty-five gallons. Among the other miscellaneous stuff taken by the raiders are about thirty barrels of mash, a large quantity of sugar, coron and the various other ingredients that go to make up the "moonshine" brand of whiskey. The raid was carried out by P. C. Shepherd, Barron and Lawlor, of Main street station, and Inland Revenue Officer Chivrell.


