Chicago, Nov. 8—Efforts to bring Caarl Wanderer, recently convicted for the murder of his wife, to trial for slaying the "ragged stranger," whom the state alleges he employed to stage a fake hold-up to cover the wife murder, failed on Saturday when Chicago attorneys refused to take the case.

Attorneys who defended Wanderer at the first trial, declined to continue as his counsel, and an appeal by Judge Pam for lawyers to volunteer, failed to get results. Wanderer will be taken to Joliet next week to begin serving a twenty-five year sentence.


