I. SEDERUNT.

HAMILTON, *Tuesday, June 12, 1860.*

7½ o'clock, P. M.

The Synod of the United Presbyterian Church in Canada met, and after Sermon by the Moderator, the Rev. William Ormiston, M. A. from Ephesians iii. 8, was constituted.

The roll of Synod, compiled from the rolls furnished by Presbytery Clerks, was called and marked.

The Reports of Presbyteries stated the following changes, affecting the roll of Synod, and the list of Probationers, as having occurred since last meeting, namely :

That there had been four ordinations, —

Thomas J. Scott, Dundas, in the Flamborough Presbytery, August 16, 1859; William Peattie, Mount Pleasant. Brant Presbytery, January 24, 1860; Robert Hall, Nissouri and Fish Creek, London Presbytery, April 17, 1860; Robert Hume, St. George, Flamborough Presbytery, May 22, 1860 :

That there had been two translations, —

The Rev. Stephen Balmer, loosed from the congregation of Woodstock, in the Presbytery of London, October 25, 1859, and inducted into the congregation of Detroit, in the same Presbytery, November 16, 1859; Translations.

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
