SOCIETIES.

Two Societies have been established, having a relation to this department. The one is designed for the benefit of the Theological Students in the College; and the other to serve as a connecting link between them and the Ministers laboring in the three Conferences of the Maritime Provinces, as well as to promote among the latter a spirit of Theological and Ministerial Culture.

Among the Students it is proposed, by means of Essays, Exegetical Papers, and Oral discussions, to stimulate enquiry as to the best methods of Ministerial efficiency, and so to assist in preparing each other for the great work of preaching the Gospel, and feeding the flock of Christ.
