to Speed Trials and Insure Punishment.

New York, June 6.—Revision of  
criminal procedure in order to speed  
up trials and to insure punishment of  
criminals, and education in ethics in  
home, school, church and state were  
urged as the chief means of checking  
and preventing crime by witnesses who  
appeared yesterday before the commit-  
tee on law enforcement of the Amer-  
ican Bar Association.
