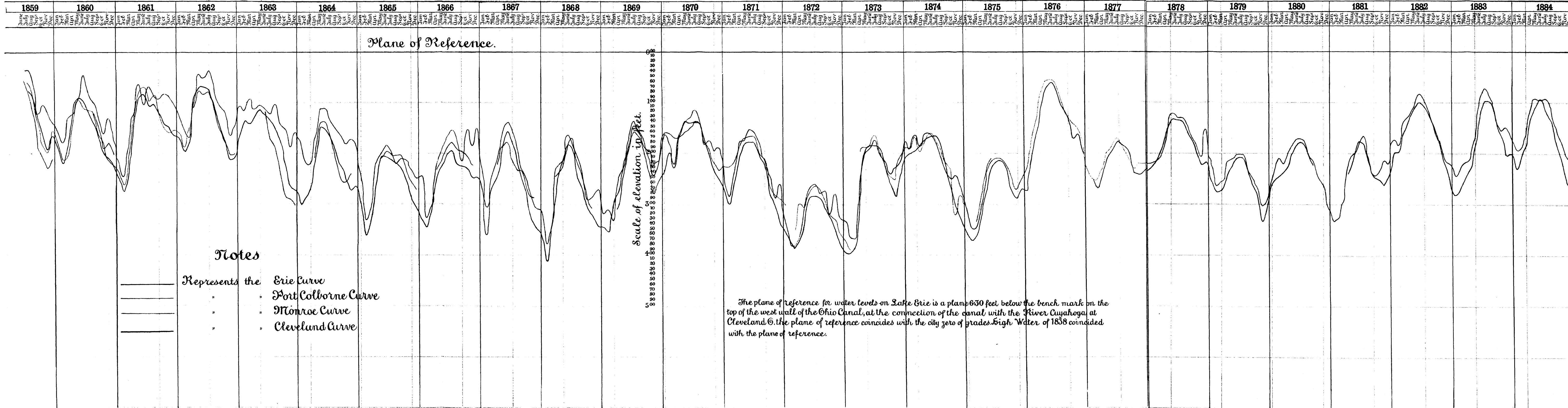


Annual Water Level Curves Lake Erie.

The plane of reference for water levels on Lake Erie is a plane 650 feet below the bench mark on the top of the west wall of the Ohio Canal, at the connection of the canal with the River Cuyahoga at Cleveland O. the plane of reference coincides with the city zero of grades. High Water of 1858 coincided with the plane of reference.
