I hereby testify that the original Letters (with the exception of the H.) were placed in my hands by the Letters with above Lands, for the purpose of chibodying them two a Memorial to His Excellency has 6 metcalf in December 1844 - and for the perpose of laying them before him when deputed together with Moho: Thoug townt upon him in Monhead in October last. I then cohilided them to the Vardon of the Indian Department who stated he had written most of them, in answers to feeters from the Lettlens, and that he did so by the orders of SP farvis Eg. 6. Dafairs and that the Letters calling for such replies lay in the office of the Undian Department in Foronto. I also exhibited and read to Mo Commussioner Thirburne and the didicin Chief assembled in Council on or about toto afril least. said original detiens. and before giving Hew back to the Settlers for the purpose of ashelihors to Molinkpatrick now making a further survey of Suid Lando and improvements. I took copies of the Saine and which are here re copiect. for handnispion to the forement through two Shorburne as commanded in October last. I further festif said original Letters had been seen and reced by me (in part) before acting as aforeseid on behelf of the Settlers, and that it mens on the faith of such Letters so put in circulation, and of other nery numerous Documents and acts of the Government indication of a paper Sale, that I mas included to purchase and continue the Unprostruction of sold. all which is respectfully humbly and Loyally, "
