	22-5-42		Rain all day. No flying at all today because of very poor weather. Twenty-seven members of the McGill Air Squadron arrived at the Station for a period of two weeks' I.T.S. training. After medical inspection, they were assigned to quarters in the barrack blocks.		
	23-5-42		Overcast. At 1725 hours on Main Aerodrome, J8366 Pilot Officer R.B. MacKenzie taxied Harvard MK 11 2588 into the re-fueling tender thereby damaging wing and propellor. Pilot uninjured.		
	24-5-42		Rain all day. No flying again today. Members of the Uplands Glee Club took part in a Canadian Broadcasting Corporation program at Rockcliffe in the afternoon. The Glee Club also combined with the choir for the evening Service in St. James United Church in Ottawa.		
	25-5-42		Overcast, low clouds. Normal Station routine was carried on all day.
