With reference to the vouchers received under cover of Mr. Bell's letter of the 1st ultimo, I have to inform you that during the summer or fall of 1881 Mr. Agent McDonald paid from annuity money in his possession vouchers amounting to \$499.⁰⁰. In the letter in which Mr. Bell forwarded these vouchers, (dated 19th Novr 1881) he acknowledged that the course was somewhat irregular, and stated that Mr. McDonald had been informed that he should not pursue the same course again. The vouchers were found correct and properly drawn.
