



Sir:-

In reply to your letter of the 24th instant respecting the fencing of the east side of Keesekouse's Reserve, I beg to say that you have neglected to give the cost. This Band has only \$514.00 at credit of its interest account. If the cost of the fence is to be a charge against interest funds of the Band, they should be given to understand that there will be no money for distribution. A resolution of the Band will be required covering the proposed expenditure.
