be necessary to continue paying two dispensers at Fairford Fairford Band. These Indians as well as those of the other bands should be strongly advised not to sell their cattle unless they have a surplus.

Ebb and Flow Lake Band. The Chief should be reprimanded for not making arrangements to take care of the medicines after Miss Adam left.

Shoal River Band . With regard to the bull asked for, the question will receive consideration when the Department is assured that these Indians will take good care of the animal. You should report further.

Swan Lake and Long Plain Bands . You shoul make the requests for seed the subject of a separate communication and give the quantities required for each band.
