Ottawa, November 15th, 1919.

Madam,-

I beg to say that the Department received the memorandum of freight charges which you submitted in connection with shipments of clothing which you sent forward to the points stated on behalf of Indians, and I may say that cheque No. 1250 for \$23.22 is going forward in payment of the freight charges on the clothing as per freight receipts submitted.

Notwithstanding the fact that payment has been made, the manner in which you accounted for the clothing forwarded is not altogether satisfactory, and I have to request that in future if shipments of clothing are made by the Woman's Missionary Society of the Methodist Church, you will be good enough to submit a memorandum such as above referred to, and also forward a list of goods shipped from the different branches of the society, to which list should be attached the freight receipts for goods shipped. A list accompanied your letter of the 1st September last is what is required as the Department desires details of the articles forwarded and estimate of value of the same.
