Mary Ann Kahentente an Indian woman of Caughnawaga has made the following declaration in the presence of the undersigned witnesses. having previously divided her property with her children. her own share of the property consists a piece of land about thirteen Acres in size. a dwelling house. barn. stable granery Erected thereon all and everything belonging to said property. she donates to her son Saksarie Kamenraktatie said property is situated on the Caughnawaga Reserve and the boundaries are as follows To the North by Louis Delisle. To the East by Mr John. W. Joek To the South by the white settlement To the West by Micheal Karoniarakwen

For and in Consideration of said donation the said Saksarie Kamenraktatie agrees and binds himself to support his mother during her life. and to defray the funeral expenses at her death she also donates to said Saksarie Kamenraktatie the following goods Mirrors Picture Frames Sewing machine Stoves Time Piece Tables. Chairs. Sleigh. Cupboard Feather Pillows Blankets and Bed covers. he also binds himself to pay her debts if any. and collect all her dues one Year Tenor watsue owing her \$19⁰⁰ Nineteen Dollars Declaration made at Caughnawaga. June 18th 1896
