The accused was then sent to an N.C.O.
^{and one month since his first application} two weeks after interviewing
Refresher School as a Gunner, transferred
to ~~Camp~~ ^{Fort} ~~Lawrence~~ where for three weeks
he was being taught in the line of —
Map Reading, Small Arms, foot drill —
and ~~lecturing on these and all~~ ^{lecturing on these and all} other subjects
and ~~many other subjects~~.

Three weeks later ^{11 Sept 1948} arriving at this
Unit again, he was put to the duties
of being taught "Basic Training" and
"fatigues". From two to three weeks
these above-mentioned consisted of his
duties. He then asked to be paraded
to Col. Inch, and was. Col. Inch
informed the accused that Col. Cort
refused to permit the man to
be an N.C.O. until Col. Inch on
looking at his Crime Sheet, Col. Inch
pulling every string to get
the accused promoted.
