Three weeks later arriving at this  
Unit again, he was put to the duties  
of being taught "Basic Training" and  
"fatigues" from two to three weeks  
these above-mentioned consisted of his  
duties. He then asked to be paraded  
to Colonel Inch, and was. Colonel Inch  
informed the Accused that Colonel  
Cortit refused to permit the man to  
be an N.C.O. until Colonel Inch on  
looking at his Crime Sheet, Colonel  
Inch pulling every string to get  
the accused promoted.
