I beg to attach, herewith, a letter, in duplicate, from the Standard Logging Company relative to that portion of Chemaimus I. R. #13 marked *C" on the Reserve Flan and located on the South East corner.

When the original surrender of this timber was given on the Reserve on December 6th, 1919, this area was exempt or not included in the surrender and, so far as I know, there is no way in which it can be logged now except the Indians give another surrender.

I beg to attach, herewith, for your information, a copy of the Plan in question which I would ask you to return with your reply.
