RESOLUTION

Moved by Councillor Gus Band.

THAT this Council having considered the letter of Mr.
Commissioner Ditchburn dated March 8th., No. 30-14-8852,
covering the report of the Dominion Water Power and
Reclamation Service dated January 12th. 1927 with respect
to a proposed water system to be installed in the
Chekwelp Reserve No. 26 of the Squamish Band at Howe
Sound, B.C.; and having carefully considered the said
report hereby resolves that the Department of Indian
Affairs be requested to have this water system installed
in Reserve No. 26. and the cost thereof charged against
the funds of the Squamish Band in trust.
