he is keeping in touch with the Metropolitan Flanning Board of Toronto. Recognizing that all this work was highly confidential but in view of the fact that so many people are involved P & I suggested that it would be well to have a statement in reserve in case the information gets out and was asked to prepare something for both Toronto and Montreal in collaboration with the regional people.

- 16. Consolidation ENG suggested that the work in both Toronto and Montreal would require additional statements from ENG and Operations in order that the full requirements might be met. MGHT would like to be sure that the Ontario and Quebec groups do not go too far at this stage and asked ENG to keep in close touch with their developing plans.
- 17. Radio Regulations Re-issue ENG indicated that the D of T had asked about legislation which might come out of the Fowler Report indicating that D of T is seriously considering drafting legislation as it fits into their part of the developing operation. They are concerned that there is to be a third technical set-up. MGMT indicated that the CBC is not drafting any legislation and is not worried at this stage.
