The standard scholarly journal in the field. Articles in French and English on many economic issues. A basic title for all university programmes including graduate studies. Was preceded by Canadian Journal of Economics and Political Science 1935 - 1967.

A more specialized publication describing the Ontario economic scene. Articles on a wide variety of issues including government finance. Useful at general university level. Although no longer published, it is still considered a useful source.
