

6. No inmate shall be allowed to trade or exchange clothing or any other article with any person whatever, or beg of those who visit them, nor shall they receive money or other articles from any one without the consent of the Superintendent or Matron.

7. All the inmates shall diligently and faithfully perform the duty or task allotted to them by the Superintendent or Matron, unless otherwise ordered.

8. Any inmate guilty of drunkenness, disobedience, obscenity, disorderly conduct, profane or indecorous language, theft, waste, or who shall absent himself or herself from the premises without the permission of the Superintendent, or who shall injure or deface any part of the house or furniture therein, or who shall commit waste or destruction of any kind in regard to property connected with the Home shall be subjected to merited punishment.

9. In all cases of solitary confinement, the person confined shall be debarred from seeing or conversing with any other person except the Commissioners, Medical Officer, Superintendent or other person employed as attendant and the food given shall consist solely of bread and water unless determined otherwise by the Medical Officer.
