

## ARTICLE XIII.

### ARREARS.

The name of any member over 12 months in arrears shall be read to the Lodge, who shall take such action as they deem advisable. The Lodge may, by giving one month's notice to him, declare him suspended for non-payment of dues, should he fail to pay the amount.

Members so suspended as being more than twelve months in arrear of dues, may upon a two-thirds open vote of the members present at a regular meeting, be restored to all the privileges of the Lodge on payment of all arrears due to the Lodge at the time they were suspended.

## ARTICLE XIV.

### LIFE MEMBERSHIP.

Any member continuing a member of this Lodge for twenty consecutive years, and having paid during that time all dues required from him by this Lodge and Grand Lodge, and on payment of the sum required by Grand Lodge to commute his dues, shall be placed on the Life Membership list and shall be exempt from the payment of the ordinary Lodge dues. A member may become a Life Member at any time by paying such sum of money as shall, with the monthly dues he has already paid, make up the amount of twenty years' dues and the Grand Lodge dues.
