
## OUR BELOVED SENIOR HON. PRESIDENT.

REV. EDWARD HARTLEY DEWART, D.D.



EDWARD HARTLEY DEWART was born in County Cavan, Iveland, parents, who settled about the centre of the Tuenship of Dummer, in 1853. Anid many drawbacks and difficulties he became as a lad quite a scholar and in 1853 walked to Toronto to attend the Normal School. Upon receiving a certificate he laught school for a few sessions, joining the Methodist Conference in 1854 as a probationer. He early became distinguished as a man of great force of character, a clear thinker, eignoring witer, powerful debuter and able preacher. In 1852 he was elected Editor of the Christian Guardian and for twenty-five geners, and supermanted, was the most pitent factor in the Methodist Church of Canada in the modeling, shaping and directing of her policy. Not done as poet, author and journalist did he everl, but also as an evangelical pecucher and broad-minded citizen. He has made a deeper impress for good upon hemanity than any other "Peterborough Boy" of his time.
