CROWN LAND DEPARTMENT, WOODS AND FORESTS BRANCH,

SIR,

I have the honor to inform you that by Order in Council, dated the 14th of February, 1857, all persons who have payments to make on account of Woods and Forests, whether of Ground Rents, Timber dues, or other charges connected with this branch of the Public Revenue, must in future deposit the amount to the credit of the Receiver General on account of the Crown Land Department, in the Bank of Upper Canada or its Agencies.

Each person will receive a certificate of deposit in triplicate from the Bank, one of which he will keep, the other two he will hand over to you, and you will transmit them to this Department along with your Monthly Returns.
