Lumber and timber are the only shipments. Stage weekly to Lion's Head, 12 miles south, fare 50c. Population, 50. Mail weekly. Alexander Currie, postmaster.

CAPE CROKER. Also known as McGregor's Harbor, a village with a good harbor of refuge on the western shore of the Georgian Bay, in the Indian reservation, in Albemarle township, Bruce County, 90 miles north of Walkerton, the county seat, and 17 north-east of Wiarton, the nearest railway and banking point. Settled in 1850. It contains Catholic and Methodist churches, and a public school, and ships live stock, fish, telegraph poles, cedar posts, timber and railway ties. Stages twice a week to Colpoys Bay and Wiarton. Population, 425. Mail semi-weekly. Frederick Lamorandiere, postmaster.
