### nopsis of Canadian North-West Land Regulations.

THE sole head of a family, or any male over 18 years old, may homestead a quarter section of available wan or Alberta. Applicant must appear in person at the Dominion Lands Agency or sub-Agency for the district. Entry by proxy may be made at any Dominion Lands Agency (out not Sub-Agency,) on certain conditions.

Duties—Six months residence upon and cultivation of the land in each of three years. A homesteader may live within nine miles of his homestead on a farm of the least 80 acres, on certain conditions. A labitable house is required except where residence is performed in the vicinity.

In certain, districts a homesteader in yood standing may pre-empt a quarter section alongwide his homestead. Price 13,00 per acre.

Pre-emption patent may be obtained as soon as homestead patent, on certain conditions.

Assettler who has exhausted his homestead right may take a purchased homestead in certain districts. Price \$3.00 peace.

London June 1-Once more London, June 1—Once more the German assault on Verdun has shifted. Forced back at Hill 304, on the left bank of the Meuse, by the spirited counter thrusts of Joffre's troops, the crown prince's masses have resumed the onslaught around Fort Douaumont on the right back of the river.
