

Ottawa, Dec. 4-The feature of the debate in the House yesterday on the address was the speech from Hon. W. 8. Fielding. The minister of finance was in particularly good form and received, as he always does, the close attention of both sides. He spoke for about two hours and as he exposed the tactics of the opposition leade: and his followers, he was cheered again and again.
