

### Bottomley Sentenced.

FORMER EDITOR GETS SEVEN YEARS-A BRILLIANT WRITER AND SPEAKER.

A special cable despatch from Lon on states that, on Monday, May 29th Horatio Bottomley, former published and editor of "John Bull" was found guilty by a jury on the charge of nisappropriation of funds belonging to the Victory Bond Club.
