## French Rock Bottom Plan is Not an Ultimatum

Plan for Evacuation of the Ruhr Submitted—U. S. Fliers at Kirkwall—60 Natives Perish on Burning Steamer.

### TO AMEND IRISH TREATY.

LONDON, July 30.

Legislation to amend the Treaty between Great Britain and Ireland is foreshadowed in the newspapers. It is stated the judicial committee of the Privy Council, which was recently entrusted with the task of examining the position the position created by Ulster's refusal to appoint a representative on the Boundary Commission, has unanimously decided that the only way to constitute a commission is by new legislation in the Imperial Parliament which would bind both the northern and southern governments of Ireland. The British Government is said to contemplate introducing a Bill at an early date, although it is recognized such a measure would be severely controversial and would create serious trouble for the Ministry and prolong the session of parliament.

### HERIOT MAKES ROCKBOTTOM PROPOSAL.

LONDON, July 31.

The new French proposal embodying Premier Herriot's rockbottom offer in concessions to break the deadlock in the Inter-Allied Conference, was handed to Prime Minister MacDonald at 4 o'clock to-day and laid before the chief delegates, who were gathered in the Prime Minister's room, House of Commons. The French delegates hope the proposals will bring the Allied delegates together on methods of launching the Dawes plan and at the same time reconcile the International Bankers' security for the Dawes plan loan to Germany. If the new plans fail, the French say, they have nothing more to offer. They do not submit the scheme in any sense of an ultimatum, they emphasize that they are not looking out of the window toward the

### 60 NATIVES PERISH ON BURNING STEAMER.

MONOLEA, July 29.

Sixty natives are believed to have perished when the motor ship Augustan burned off the Coast of Camiguin Island, in the Sea of Mindanao, says a telegram received here from the commander of constabulary in Misami. The telegram stated the Inter-Island steamer Antonio Costa rescued about sixty persons from the burning vessel. The Augustan was a wooden steamer, 195 tons, built in Fort Ludlow in 1879, and owned by the Augustan Coconut Company. She plied between the Southern Islands of the Philippines.

### THE PLAN OF EVACUATION.

LONDON, July 31.

The semi-official Havas Agency of France is in a position to give the first summary of the Ruhr evacuation plan submitted at the Inter-Allied Conference here and elaborated under the direction of M. J. Seydoux. After the floating of the loan of eight hundred million gold marks by Germany, French and Belgian troops would evacuate Hanen. After the is-

use of each of the three slices of the two billion German industrial railroad bonds, French and Belgian troops would evacuate successively Dortmund, Bochum and Essen. If the markets were unable to absorb the issue of two billion German industrial railroad bonds, the troops, nevertheless, would definitely leave Ruhr by August 15th, 1926, on condition that the Reichstag would have fulfilled all the obligations of the Dawes plan. The arbitration formula as finally drafted will apply to disagreements of the reparations committee concerning defaults and non-execution of German industrial contracts and appeals from decisions of reparations commission.

### ANOTHER TRAGEDY AT THE LEVEL CROSSING.

NEWCASTLE, Ont., July 30.

Four persons were killed and three injured, two seriously, when a motor car in which they were riding, was struck by a fast freight train at Adams Crossing, a few miles from here, shortly afternoon to-day. The dead are Mrs. and Miss Burroughes, of Newcastle; Mrs. Stewart, of Toronto; Morris Cambridge, a boy, of Gladstone Ave., Toronto. The injured are the parents of the Cambridge boy and James Cambridge, another son. Mrs. Cambridge and her son James are said to be in a critical condition.

### A MIX-UP WITH K.K.K.

LANCASTER, Mass., July 30.

After a night of disorders and clashes in which scores were injured, a crowd of men who had engaged in a night of hostilities with members and spectators at a Ku Klux Klan meeting in a field near here, were dispersed with the arrival of additional State patrolmen to-day. Between 500 and 800 men had engaged in the fighting.

### ZAGLOUL IN PARIS.

PARIS, July 30.

Zagloul Pasha Egyptian Premier, arrived in Paris this morning. He is still quite weak from the effects of the wound suffered in the recent attempt on his life at Cairo.

### FLEISCHMANN DIVORCED.

PARIS, July 30.

A divorce on the grounds of abandonment to-day has been granted to Mrs. Laura G. Hyland Hemingway Fleischmann, wife of Julius Fleischmann, former Mayor of Cincinnati. A fortnight ago Mr. Fleischmann, the great rival, admitted his wife was suing for divorce in the Paris courts. While the terms of the decree are not made known, and while Mr. Fleischmann refused to discuss them it is understood they included a settlement of \$5,000,000 on Mrs. Fleischmann. Mr. and Mrs. Fleischmann were married in 1920. Both had been married previously and divorced.

### INVENTOR OF DEATH RAY LOSING HIS SIGHT.

NEW YORK, July 30.

Harry Grindell Matthews, English inventor of alleged death ray, has been under treatment for falling eyesight during the past week. One of the inventor's eyes is completely sightless, it has become known, and the use of the other eye is considerably impaired.

### U. S. FLIERS AT KIRKWALL.

KIRKWALL, Orkney Island, July 30.

### PLEA OF INSANITY.

CHICAGO, July 30.

The possibility that judicial hearing to determine the punishment of Nathan Leopold and Richard Loeb, for killing Robert Franks, may be annulled and a jury sworn in to pass on their sanity, appeared to-day with the defence planning to submit testimony of its alienists in spite of the State's declaration to oppose any evidence touching their mental responsibility.

### INDUSTRIAL DISTRICTS OF SAO BADLY DAMAGED.

BUENOS AIRES, July 30.

The industrial districts of Sao Paulo were badly damaged during the insurrectionary period, according to messages from Santos describing the conditions in Sao Paulo as they were found by managers of large foreign enterprises who returned to the city to examine the conditions of their property.

### THREAT OF INDIAN REVOLUTION.

ALICUTTA, India, July 30.

Printed leaflets without any signature or anything to indicate their origin, are being circulated among the Bengal Revolutionary Council has passed a resolution to begin a campaign of ruthless assassination of police officers. Undoubtedly the object of these anonymous leaflets is to cause a stampede of the native police force who hitherto have remained staunch.
