The Liverpool Fat Cattle Show, as breeders well know, as one of the most considerable, if it be not the most important one held in the United Kingdom, and, speaking of it, the reporter of the Liverpool Mercury says:—"The most attractive animals in the show were a splendid Hereford, bred and fed upon the model farm at Windsor, and a Devon heifer, shown by H. R. H., the Prince of Wales from his farm at Sandringham. The first of these gained the first prizes at Smithfield and Birmingham, and an extra prize of £30, as the best Hereford. The bullock belonging to the Prince of Wales is an animal of remarkable symmetry and small bone, but it was fairly beaten on this occasion by a splendid Galloway heifer exhibited by Mr. William Rigg, Banks, Kirkeudbright. She was bred by the Earl of Selkirk."


