New York, June 27.—A Washington dispatch to The Herald says it is learned from the Department that instructions have been given to collectors of customs at ports on the Canadian border to take a census or to try to ascertain the number of men who live in Canada but who work on this side and cross the border at night.

On May 18 Assistant Secretary Thompson wrote to the Collector at Niagara, in reply to his inquiry, calling his attention to the Customs Act of Feb. 26, 1885, which provides for the detention of men who are found on this side of the border at night.
