Old Masters But Nos Ausiquities.

WASHINGTON, Sept. 7.—The Treasury Department has declined to grant the request of H. Marquand of New York for a modification of the decision relative to the importation of collections of antiquities. The correspondent wished the decision, which defined such works as those produced before the year 1700, modified so as to admit free paintings of Reynolds, Gainsborough and other artists who lived about the year 1800 and recognized by the British Museum as "old Masters." The department holds that these works are not antiquities in any proper sense of the term and that such a radical modification as that soughs can be made only by set of Congress.
