And they are now settling on the Branches of Sasquebanab River; and from the western Branches of this River, there is but a small Land-Carriage to Allegbery, a Branch of that great River Missisppi; which Branch extending a thousand Miles from in Mouth, where it enters the said River; and which joins so near to our Settlements, as is above taken notice of, opens us a Trade to that vast Country, ealled by the French Louisiana, which they possess on the Missisppi.
