

from Bay, to Bay, may with much facility discover the whole Countrey.

From the Bay of *S. Peter*, round about the West side of the land, till you come to the grand Bay, which lyeth on the North-side of the Countrey; and so from thence, till you come round, back to *Trinity Bay*, are abundance of large and excellent Bayes; which are y<sup>e</sup> lesse known, because not frequēd by the *English*, who seldom fish to y<sup>e</sup> Northward of *Trinity Bay*. And it is to be obserued, that round about the Coast and in the Bayes, there are many small I-lands, (none of them further off then a league from the land) both faire and fruitfull: neither doth any one part of the world afford greater store of good Harbors, more free from dangers, or more commodious, then are there built by the admirable workmanship of God; I will onely instance 2. or three of the chiefeſt, for some ſpeciall reaſons.

*Trinity Harbor* lyes neere in 49. degrees North-latitude, being very cōmodiously ſeated to receiue ſhipping in reaſonable weather, both to anchor in, & from thence to ſaile towards either the Eaſt, Weſt, or South: It hath three Armes or Riuers, long and large enough for many hundred ſaile of Ships, to moare faſt at Anchor neere a mile from the Harbors mouth; cloſe adioyning to the Ri- uers ſide, and within the Harbor is much open land, well ſtored with graſſe, Winter and Summer, to maintaine ſtore of ordinary cattell, beſides Hogges and Goats, and it ſtandeth North, moſt of any Harbor in the land, where our Nation praſtiſeth fiſhing; It is neer vnto a great Bay lying on the North-side of it, called the Bay of *Flowers*; to which place no Ships reſpaire to fiſh; partly in regard of ſundry Rocks & Ledges lying euen with the wa- ter, & full of danger; but chiefly (as I coniecture) becauſe the Sauage people of that Countrey doe there inhabit: many of them ſecretly euery yeere, come into *Trinity Bay*
