St. Nicholas died on December 6th, in 327. His emains were brought to Bari, in Sicily. One of his inger-joints is kept at St. Nicholas du-Port, and the magnificent gothic church dedicated in that city to the patron Saint of Lorraine, impatiently awaits the owerful inspiration that will bring thousands of digrims to the foot of the altar where, after so many there, knelt of yore the noble virgin of Domremy, the liberatrix of France.

-Young readers, do not forget to pray to St. Wholas during the holy month of December—when king him for Christmas or New Year's gifts, head the list with those virtues that make childhood so welly and happy: innocence, candor and truthfulness, key and obedience. The good Saint who loves you well will obtain them for you from the Christ-child
