ARTICLE V

In order to secure a proper escapement of sockeye salmon during the spring of he chinook salmon fishing season, the Commission may prescribe the size of the meshes in all fishing gear and appliances that may be operated during said season in the Control of the size of th in the Canadian waters and/or the waters of the United States of Americal and described in Article I. of the Canadian waters and or the waters of the United States of Americal described in Article I of this Convention. At all seasons of the year the Company mission may prescribe the size of the meshes in all salmon fishing gear and appliances that may be operated on the High Seas embraced in paragraph numbered 1 of Article I of this Convention, provided, however, that in so far as concerns the High Seas, requirements prescribed by the Commission under the authority of this paragraph shall apply only to nationals and inhabitants and vessels and boats of the Dominion of Canada and the United States of America.

Whenever, at any other time than the spring or chinook salmon fishing seal the talking of salmon fishing seal son, the taking of sockeye salmon in Canadian waters or in waters of the United States of America is not prohibited under an order adopted by the Commission any fishing gear or appliance authorized by the laws of the Dominion of Canada may be used in Canadian waters by any person thereunto duly authorized and any fishing generalized by the laws of the Dominion of Canadian waters by any person thereunto duly authorized and any fishing gear or appliance authorized by the State of Washington may be used in waters of the Tribel Country and the Tribel Countr be used in waters of the United States of America by any person thereund authorized by the State of Washington.
