I have the honor to refer to Your Excellency's note of August 13, 1985 which concerns the Treaty between the Government of Canada and the Government of the United States of America concerning Pacific Salmon and which confirms on behalf of the Government of Canada the understanding that has been reached between our two Governments concerning the implementation of Article XV, paragraph 3 of the Treaty.

I also have the honor to inform the Government of Canada that the understanding is acceptable to the Government of the United States and that your note and this reply constitute an agreement between the United States of America and Canada.
