- (15) Canada normally makes a cash contribution of \$500,000 to the UNRWA; since 1958-59 this has been augmented by special donations of Canadian wheat flour. In 1967 the wheat-flour donation was increased by \$2,155,000 (including transportation costs of \$300,000) owing to the June hostilities in the Middle East.
- (16) Includes \$254,000-worth of canned fish and \$195,000-worth of white beans in 1948 and \$198,000-worth of canned fish and \$73,000-worth of flour in 1959 for Palestine refugees.
- (17) Includes a \$23,000 contribution to the FAO "Freedom-from-Hunger" campaign.
- (18) Figures include both cash and commodity contributions.
- (19) The IMCO was established as a UN Specialized Agency in 1958.
- (20) Includes \$100,000 contribution to the WHO Malaria Eradication Programme.
- (21) The WMO was established as a Specialized Agency in 1951.
- (22) Assessment for membership in the ITU for 1945-46 and 1946-47 estimated at \$2,800 annually on the basis of 1947-48 assessment.
