The Department of External Affairs has been informed by the Swedish Legation in Ottawa that on September 1, 1948, the Government of Sweden terminated the task of protecting Hungarian interests in Canada. The Swedish Government had agreed to take over the protection of the interests of several foreign countries, including Hungary, during the war, and these activities have been terminated gradually since the respective treaties of peace were signed.

The Department has been advised by the Legation of Poland that the Government of Poland has agreed to undertake the protection of Hungarian interests in Canada in the absence of direct Hungarian representation in this country.
