- No. 3.—Fourth (Ocean Freight Rates and Transportation Companies), Fifth (Freight Rates on Shipments from Eastern Canadian Ports), Sixth (Rural Credits), and Seventh Reports of the Special Committee appointed to inquire into Agricultural Conditions,—Submitting a printed copy of its proceedings and the evidence given before the Committee; also certain documents and articles in connection therewith but not contained in the proceedings. The inquiry was subdivided under the subjects of,—(a) Production, (b) Transportation, Distributing and Marketing, (c) Rural Credits, and (d) Relation of prices obtained by the agriculturists as producers and paid by them as consumers. Suggestions for consideration and recommendations are contained in the aforesaid reports; also recommendation in respect to printing in blue-book form for distribution, and as appendix to the Journals. *Printed.
