PRAYERS.

Mr. Sauvé, a Member of the King's Privy Council, presented,—Return to an Order of the House of the 22nd February, 1932, for a copy of all correspondence, reports and other documents in connection with the creation of a vacancy in the postmastership at Cap St. Ignace, County of Montmagny, Quebec, and the appointment, temporary or otherwise, of a new postmaster, together with a copy of correspondence, applications, recommendations and other communications received from persons desirous of obtaining the new appointment, or others on their behalf.

Also,—Return to an Order of the House of the 7th March, 1932, for a copy of all correspondence, reports, or other documents relating to the dismissal of Noel Fontaine, postmaster at Laprairie, county of Laprairie, Quebec, including full report of an inquiry into charges brought against him, with proof and evidence submitted thereto; also a copy of all correspondence, reports and other documents relating to the appointment of his successor.

Also,—Return to an Order of the House of the 29th February, 1932, for a copy of the complete file in connection with the dismissal of J. H. Couture as postmaster at Frampton, county of Dorchester, and the appointment of his successor.

And also,—Return to an Order of the House of the 2nd March, 1932, for a copy of all correspondence and reports or petitions in connection with the dismissal of the postmaster at Dequen, Quebec, and the appointment of his successor.

The House resumed the Debate on the proposed motion of Mr. Bennett: That Mr. Speaker do now leave the Chair for the House to resolve itself into Committee of the Whole to consider a proposed Resolution declaring it expedient to introduce a Bill to amend Chapter 58 of the Statutes of Canada, 1931, striking out the word "March" in Section 8, and substituting the word "May" therefor.
